## SURVEY TO INFORM THE FUTURE OF MARQUETTE LAND USE

The City of Marquette has launched an online survey to solicit input from residents and visitors. Information gathered from the survey will be used in the development of the Master Plan, a long-range document that guides future development and land use in the City.

"Depending on who you talk to in Marquette, there are a lot of different ideas about how our community could or should change over the next 20 years," says Dennis Stachewicz, Director of Community Development. "This survey provides a means to capture those ideas to guide our goals and Master Plan."

The survey is open until Wednesday, January 25, and includes questions about city priorities, the quality of public facilities and services in Marquette, and opportunities and challenges facing city neighborhoods.
